Also, we have a special appeal to the Guardians particularly those who serve the government sector and the organized sector where there is practically no loss of pay or no delay of payment or no curtailment of payment to please pay on time. It is difficult to appreciate delay of payment from them by taking the alibi of COVID, which has not affected them financially. Please note that time has come for all of us to roll up our sleeves and do our best to sustain this collectively. You're paying on time will help your child's friend's father to delay a little bit because he is suffering. So our Earnest appeal to those, if you do not have any loss of pay or delay in payment, please pay on time. This is an earnest request and very sincere request a humble request with folded hands.
